
Celebration of Independence Day





With these, the lecture went towards the question & answer sessions, where all the attendees posed their questions regarding the current scenario of India and Covid -19 with its impact on them.


With this Asst. Prof. Pawan Sir also declared the results of the poster competition. The winners were: -






