

He explained various steps and smart techniques for study.






## Day -3 Litigation

#### Recourse person - Mr. Siddharth Agarwal, High Court Advocate



## Advanced Certificate Course in Civil and Criminal Practice 2021-22





As a result, this course was renamed Advanced Certificate Course in Civil and Criminal Practice and the syllabus was revised to meet the requirements. There were 32 hours in the course. It began on May 10, 2022, and it ended on May 28, 2022.


Dr. Deepti Bhargava was the winner of this activity.

In this activity, each faculty received an appreciation note from students. Each faculty was asked to read the note in front of presented crowd as everyone would get to know the amazing qualities each person possess.






#### REPORT



#### MOOT PROBLEM

#### Moot Problem 1:

#### A v/s Secretary of Health and Family Dept.

A, was a 24 yr old single woman, having 3 sisters and a mother living in Banipur.

- . She met B, a 28 yr old man and they had a live-in-relationship.
- . During the cohabitation, A conceived their child.
- . Due to this A asked B, to marry her for legitimizing their child.
- · However despite multiple requests from A, B refused to marry her.
- Already plagued with responsibilities, A did not want to add up to her troubles by being a single Mother.
- A approached to the High court for seeking permission to terminate her 22 week pregnancy out of consensual relationship.
- High Court denied her permission by reference to the provisions of the Medical Termination of Pregnancy Act 1961, which allowed only married woman to undergo abortion after 20 weeks
- She was not covered in any clauses under MTP Rules, 2003 on account of mental anguish, rape and health complications.
- She approached the Supreme Court on grounds of social stigma & harassment pertaining to unmarried single parent & continuation of unwanted pregnancy as it would involve a risk of the grave & immense injury to her mental, physical, social and financialhealth.

#### Issues:-

- 1. Whether the rule 3B (2) of MTP Rules 2021 is violative of Article 14 of the Indian Constitution since it excludes an unmarried woman & deprives her access to safe & legal abortion?
- 2. Whether denial of Right to abortion violates the right to privacy under provisions of Constitution of India?
- 3. Any relevant issue

#### Moot Problem 2:

# MrAloknath Patil v. Dep. Speaker, Maharajya Legislative Assembly

Aryana is the largest democratic country whose laws are similar with that of India. There are many national as well as regional political parties contributing towards national politics. The State of Maharajya is one of the prosperous States of Aryana.

- In the year 2019, during the Maharajya Legislative Assembly elections, People's Party and Garjana Party contested the election jointly under the Royal alliance.
- There were two other Political parties who fought as Forward alliance.
- Due to power sharing conflict, People's Party and Garjana Party could not form the Government amicably. As a result, Garjana Party formed an alliance with the parties in the forward alliance and formed a separate "Maha forward alliance".
- In the month of June of 2022, one of the MLA's from Garjana party, Mr. Aloknath Patil, claimed of having gathered the support of two-third MLAs declared himself as a leader of Garjana Party.
- Meanwhile, the leader Mr. SudhavAkhade who was the leader of Garjana Party called for an emergency party meeting in which the rebel Mr. Aloknath Patil and his supporting MLAs remained absent.
- Hence Mr. SudhavAkhade as a result of clear rebellion urged for the disqualification proceedings to be initiated against Mr. Aloknath Patil and his supporting MLAs for defecting from Garjana Party and it was approved by the Deputy Speaker of the Maharajya Legislative Assembly.
- On the same day, two independent MLAs moved a no confidence motion against the Deputy Speaker.
- The Deputy Speaker gave the rebellion MLAs two days to respond to the disqualification notice.
- In course of time, a no confidence motion was passed against the Forward Alliance as a
  result of the defection of Mr. Aloknath Patil and his supporting MLAs.
- Subsequently Mr. Aloknath Patil and his supporting MLAs formed an alliance with the People's Party & proceeded to form the Government in the State of Maharajya.
- Mr. Aloknath Patil and his supporters challenged the disqualification proceedings before the Apex Court.

#### Issues:

1. Does the rebellion by Mr. Aloknath Patil and his supporters amount to defection?








College got tremendous response for this conference. Total 76 participants registered and 57 participated in this Seminar.


#### Session-II

#### Session-III

#### Dr. Arwah Madan Associate Professor, Dept of Economics, St. Mira's College

#### Topic-Current financial crisis in the Neighbouring Economics and its impact

Dr. Arwah Madan Associate Professor, Dept of Economics St. Mira's College for Girls Pune, The emphasis of Madam was on impact of climate change and alternate fuel resourcing. Threat of Global Economic with a eye opener Crisis in India. After summarizing the severity of the current crisis, she deals with the impact of the crisis on the Indian economy, discusses the monetary and fiscal policy responses to the crisis, while providing a critical assessment of the policy responses. In the final section she recommend some policy measures that are needed to reverse the downturn.

With very limited fiscal maneuverability and the monetary policy constrained by the trade off between holding down interest rates and preventing inflationary tendencies, the focus of policy measures must be to further raise India's potential output growth rate. Various agencies have set the target growth rate between 8.5–9.0% as mentioned by her

Mr. Abdul Muheet Chowdhary Senior Program Officer, South Centre, Geneva

Topic- To recognize the role of different international stakeholders in dealing with financial crisis

Mr. Abdul Muheet Chowdhary Senior Program Officer, South Centre, Geneva highlighted the south centre and the global perception of shifting of power from West to East. The South Centre is the intergovernmental organization of developing countries that helps developing countries to combine their efforts and expertise to promote their common interests in the international arena.

The South Centre was established by an Intergovernmental Agreement which came into force on 31 July 1995. Its headquarters are in Geneva, Switzerland.

Achieving the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs), particularly poverty eradication, requires national policies and an international regime that supports and does not undermine development efforts. The South Centre is an intergovernmental policy research think-tank composed of and accountable to developing country Member States. It conducts policy-oriented research on key policy development issues, and supports developing countries to effectively participate in international negotiating processes that are relevant to the achievement of SDGs. The Centre promotes the unity of the South in such processes while recognizing the diversity of national interests and priorities.



#### Session-V

#### Prof. Attiya Waris UN Independent Expert on Foreign Debt

#### Topic- To examine policy initiatives for Sustainable Economic Development.

Dr. Attiya Warris enlightened the participants on the working of UN in respect of foreign debt and about the international financial obligations. As per her, concerted global efforts are required to address the climate challenges along with other developmental imperatives. Implementing India's Nationally Determined Contributions requires investments of scale and size which is unprecedented. This essentially means that along with domestic public budgets, international public finance and private sector resources would have to be mobilized from a variety of sources.

- Agriculture and Animal Husbandry IV.
- Engineering & Technology V.
- Medicine and Pharmacy VI

## Eligibility Rules:

- 1. Only bona-fide, full time students, who is enrolled for a degree or post graduate degree or diploma course of a minimum duration of one academic year and whose examination is conducted by the University subsequent to passing of the 12th class examination will be eligible for participation in this competition.
- 2. Students of open Universities shall be considered to be bona-fide students and shall be eligible to participate provided they fulfill other terms and conditions. However, students enrolled in correspondence courses in the institutions / Centers of Universities, Casual students, external students and students pursuing bridge courses shall not be eligible.

All the participants in Avishkar shall fulfill one of the following conditions as per the category of participation.

Undergraduate:

Students pursuing bachelors degree programme in the participating university or its conducted/affiliated colleges or recognized institutes who are below the age of 25 are eligible to participate in any of the six disciplines under this category depending upon the area of his/her research work irrespective of the faculty/stream/subject in which he/she has enrolled for the degree or diploma in the participating university.

#### Post-Graduate:

Any students who has completed his/her bachelors degree and pursuing post graduate studies in the participating university or its constituents/affiliated colleges or recognized institutes who is below the age of 30 is eligible to participate on any of the six disciplines under this category depending upon the area of his/her research work, irrespective work of the faculty/stream/subject in which he/she has enrolled for the post graduate degree/diploma in the participating university.

#### Post-PG:

Any person having a post graduate degree/diploma and has registered for a diploma/degree such as M. Phil., Ph.D., D.Sc., D.Lit., etc or is pursuing Post Doctoral Research in the participating university or its constituents/affiliated colleges or recognized institutes is eligible to participate in any of the six disciplines under this category depending upon the area of his/her research work, irrespective of the faculty/stream/subject in which he/she has enrolled without any stipulated age limit,

Only those teachers working in the University departments or affiliated colleges/ institutions of Savitribai Phule Pune University who are pursuing their M. Phil. /Ph.D. will be allowed to participate in Avishkar in this category

#### General Instructions:

- 1. A Student shall not be allowed to represent more than one university during a single academic year.
- 2. Provisional admission to a course in a participating university or college shall not make the student eligible to represent the university in Avishkar.





successfully planted trees during the event, marking a significant step towards our environmental conservation goals.





- 4. Education: Workshops on river conservation and hygiene were organized for local communities.







## Consumer Court Visit


A group of over 40 students of the Modern Law College, Pune had the opportunity to visit consumer court at (place) to gain firsthand experience of the legal proceedings and the consumer grievance redressal system on 15th March, 2023. 





# Report on Resume Writing seminar

"Marketing yourself is much important than marketing any product". Whenever you go for any job interview, your selection or rejection depends upon your Resume and presentation skills. In other words, Resume shows your personality at first glance. Many of people wonder, 'how to write resume' or 'how an ideal resume should be look like?'

To get answers of all the questions related to resume writing, Placement cell of Progressive Education Society's Modern Law College, Ganeshkhind, Pune organized a lecture cum seminar on Resume Writing and Interview Skills. The lecture is organized by Prof. Kaustubh Ghate and Dhanashree Patil of Modern Law College and conducted by Mrs. Swapna Menon. This seminar was conducted on 4th October 2022.

Mrs. Swapna Menon have army background and working in the Interview field since 10 years. She is one of the best mentors and expert I've ever seen. Like other regular speakers, she did not wasted time in introductions and formalities and changed the aura and energy of students positively within minutes. The session was more like communicative than one way speech. She started her session with the question to us, "Have you judged me by my entry and appearance?" After getting an affirmative answer she continued her session with great energy and positive attitude. She told us that, first impression is last impression and it lasts forever.

She also guides us on how to write resume. In the session she instructed us that one must work on grooming oneself decent enough at the least not to taint one's image, if not impress. She then moved on giving us guideline on how to write resume. Further, she mentioned that the resume should not be copy pasted from the internet or from any template, but should be actually self-typed or hand written and must show your qualities. The self-typed resume is best for selection because it shows the interviewer your confidence. Also she mentioned that the resume should not be more than 1 to 2 pages. The reason behind it is, the interviewer or recruiter doesn't have much time to look over your lengthy resume and it may affect your selection too. The interviewer looks your resume just for 5 seconds and not more than that.

While she was giving in handy tips on what to and what not to include in the Resume, she made us do a SWOT analysis. An analysis of our individual Strengths, Weaknesses, Opportunities and Threats. She asked everyone to make 4 columns on paper and write our Strengths, Weaknesses, Opportunities and Threats, 4 to 5 of each.

STRENGTH - It shows our positive factors or what qualities of us can be useful for the required job.

WEAKNESS - It shows lacunas in us which is stopping us or working as an obstacles to reach to our goals.

OPPORTUNITIES - These are the ways and preams available to us in finding an employment.

THREATS - It shows and based mostly on external factors that may not be able to be controlled by us. E.g. competition, corruption, bias selection, Nepotism, Partiality etc.

Moving forward, Mrs. Swapna Menon showed us a tutorial on how to write a Resume. Basically she gave us an idea about an ideal resume which could be focused and assessed by HR and recruiters. An ideal resume must be short and crisp. She told us 5 important points of resume,

- 1) Name and Title Your name should at the top most of your resume. Moreover, it should be with title tag like Innovator, Creator etc.
- 2) About yourself In this column, you must present your skills and qualities. This section is kind of heart of your resume. You can write your qualities, your nature, your character etc. In other words, this column speaks about your motives and goals behind getting the job.
- 3) Present and Previous Organization Here you can mention the organizations and firms with whom you have worked till the date. Also, you can mention your current organization and your position in the organization.
- 4) Educational Qualification Here you must mention your education qualification since your school to the recent degree or diploma.
- 5) Skills and achievement Here in this column, you must include your skills, achievements till the date, special rewards and prizes earned for performance etc. Also. You can include your extra curricular activities and achievements in it.

Moving forward, she introduced us with the standard questions which are expected in the interview. The basic questions are - 'Tell me something about yourself', 'Why should we hire you?', 'what do you know about us?', 'what are your strengths and weaknesses?', 'on what project you worked recently?', 'what difficulties you faced in the project?' and so on

Then, she gave us guidelines on how to approach to interview. Here she told us two ways to appear for interview. Firstly, before te interview, you should research on yourself as well as the organization in which you want to apply for job. You must be ready for any question regarding you and must be ready with some basic information of the organization. Later, you should be aware with the job description and general awareness. You must have knowledge of the position for which you have applied for and the work regarding it. Then, you must practice with mock interviews and recording

Secondly, During the interview, Relax your mind. You should be confident and should not be nervous and hesitated. You must avoid long pauses or speedy talks during the interview. It shows your nervousness and lack of confidence. You have to talk and speak more than interviewer as it represents your communication skills and command over language and thoughts to the interviewer.

While ending the session, Ms. Swapna gave us some key points to remember on interviewing skills. She told us 5 main key points as follows -

- 1) Focus
- 2) Self confidence
- 3) Know your resume
- 4) Know the organization
- Presence of mind.



Sapna Madam shared with us a STAR formula

S-Situation;

T - Tackle;

A - Alternative;

R - Result.

She advised us to always be prepared with this analysis about oneself as to how we have faced a crucial or difficult situation in our professional as well as our personal lives. The steps we took to tackle the situation at hand, the alternative solution that was found and ultimately how victoriously you emerged out of the problem i.e., the result.

Concluding the session, Asst Prof. Mr. Pravin Lokhande gave thanksgiving speech and expressed gratitude on behalf of the college and students for giving her precious time and knowledge with us. In the end, Swapna madam expressed her overwhelming experience and gratitude for inviting her to the college.




# Lecture-2-Vedic Jurisprudence on 19/04/2023 at 10:30 am in L-7 Classroom.


#### **Constitution Day Celebration**

The main objectives to conduct Reading activity to develop the habits of reading of fictional and non-fictional literature, also they have to know the college out of syllabus collection of books. They have to inculcate reading habits and to improve their vocabulary.

Dr. Sunita Mane – the Librarian given an overview of the Late Sri. P.N. Panicker, Father of the Library Movement in Kerala, The activities of the *Kerala Grandhasala Sangham* that he initiated triggered a popular cultural movement in Kerala which produced universal literacy in the state in the 1990s.


Panicker led the formation of Thiruvithaamkoor Granthasala Sangham (Travancore Library Association) in 1945 with 47 rural libraries. The slogan of the organization was 'Read and Grow'. Later on, with the formation of Kerala State in 1956, it became Kerala Granthasala Sangham (KGS). He traveled to the villages of Kerala proclaiming the value of reading. He succeeded in bringing some 6,000 libraries into this network. Grandhasala Sangham won the 'Krupsakaya Award' from UNESCO in 1975. Panicker was the General Secretary of Sangham for 32 years, until 1977, when it was taken over by the State Government. It became the Kerala State Library Council, with an in-built democratic structure and funding.

The event culminated by Vote of thanks proposed by Dr. Deepti Bhargava. All the students enjoyed the book reading session and promises to improve the reading habits.
