

Sharing of resources between the institutes and conducting mentorship programs for the students


SCOPE OF AGREEMENT:

This memorandum of understanding has been signed between Progressive Education Society's Modern Law College (MLC)as the First Party and Rayat Shikshan Sansth's Ismailsaheb Mulla

Law College, Sataraas the Second Party for the purpose of academic/institutional collaboration that will encompass the exchange of students and members of faculty between the two parties as well as other scholarly activities, research, and publication. TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF COOPERATION: 1.

- a. Modern Law College and IMLC-Satarashall collaborate in mutually agreeable events, teaching, training, and research, wherever feasible. Such collaboration will be based on mutually agreeable terms, and conditions expressly agreed for each of

- c. Faculty members of both parties shall be invited for seminars, conferences, and teaching at the doctoral level. The financial implications shall be worked out on a
- d. Modern Law College and IMLC-Satara shall collaborate in conductingState-level moot court competitions and clinical legal education.
- e. Modern Law College and IMLC-Satara shall collaborate in conducting outreach programs. A village shall be adopted for the Clinical Legal Education. Such Legal Aid Camps should be undertaken in the region of Maharashtra.
- f. The modalities for a similar exchange of researchers and faculty members will be laid down through mutual discussion that should be made operational for five
- Certificate courses conducted in collaboration, for which there will be faculty members and students from both the institutions will be able to participate in the course for which Modern Law College, Punewill give certificate.
- The Ph. D scholars of both parties shall be allowed to make use of the library resources of each other and to have academic interaction with the faculty.
 - Research Scholars and the teaching faculty of both parties will explorethe possibility of taking up collaborative research work and also apply for funding from national and international agencies, governments, and other funding
- Any financial implications emerging out of such collaborations (other than the fees of the students) shall be worked out and the decision will be taken with
- In case of any dispute that may crop up during the execution of the MoU, the matter shall be settled through arbitration, to the Arbitration Committee of a





member nominated each by both the parties and one member jointly nominated by both the parties.

AREAS OF COOPERATION: II.

This Memorandum expresses a mutual desire by MLC and IMLC-Satarato cooperate in building intellectual and research capacity and scholarship. Additional areas of cooperation may be added by the written consent of both the parties. Both the parties will act in good faith to ensure that the objectives in this memorandum are realized.

TERMS OF AGREEMENT: III.

Progress in realizing the terms and conditions referred to herein will be reviewed periodically as mutually agreed and the memorandum may be amended at any time by mutual consent in writing.

INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY AND CONFIDENTIALITY: IV.

- a. In respect of each project and programs of co-operation, the parties shall negotiate and mutually agree in writing on their respective rights to intellectual property and commercial exploitation of the same (including without limitation, trademarks and service marks, copyright, patents, designs, and confidential information pertaining thereto)
- b. Neither party shall, at any time disclose to any third party any confidential information of the other party which is acquired within the course of activities under this Memorandum, a collaborative project or a programme, without the prior consent of the other party.

The Confidentiality obligations herein will not apply to information in the public domain, information in the possession of the receiving party prior to the disclosure of the information; information which is independently developed by the receiving party; information required to be released by law; and information which is rightfully received by the receiving party from third parties without any breach of confidentiality obligations.

NON-BINDING NATURE OF MEMORANDUM:

Nothing in this Memorandum shall be construed as creating any contract, partnership, agency or other legal relationship between the parties. This Memorandum is only a non-binding statement of intent to foster genuine and mutually beneficial collaboration.

VI.

a. This Memorandum shall come into force immediately upon its signature by the parties,



- b. The validity of this Memorandum of Understanding is initially for a period of five years from the date of its execution, and the same can be further extended on mutual agreement.
- c. Either party can terminate this Memorandum of Understanding by giving six months' written notice to the other party without jeopardizing the coursework or registration of any institution's students. The implementation and/or continuance of programs or projects established pursuant to this memorandum prior to the effective date of termination shall not be affected by the termination of this memorandum.

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MOU)



This Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) is made on 02nd September, 2022 between P.E.S. Modern Law College, Ganeshkhind, Pune-400116(hereafter, called the 'First Party')
