MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

The present Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) is signed on 26/07/2023 by and between

VDCEF's Victor Dantas Law College, Kudal, Sindhudurg, 416520, affiliated to Mumbai University, hereinafter referred to as VDLC, hereby represented by its Principal, Shilpa Margaj Hirlekar

And

P.E.S.'s Modern Law College, affiliated to Savitribai Phule Pune University, Pune- Maharashtra, hereinafter referred to a MLC, hereby represented by it's Principal, Dr. Ananya Bibave.

In order to advance and enrich their academic programmes VDLC and MLC, both of which are imparted in conosance with the UGC, and both institutions being recognised by the Bar Council of India, herewith mutually entering into a formal MOU to promote the exchange of students, the exchange of faculty members, research exchange, the promotion of their respective academic programmes and initiatives, and the preparation of joint initiatives.

Article 1-Definitions

In this MOU, the following terms when used herein shall have the following meanings:

- 1. Exchange Period- the period during which a student who participates in the exchange programme under this MOU, which period shall be decided on case to case basis.
- 2. Exchange Student- a student who participates in the exchange programme under this MOU.
- 3. Faculty Member- a Faculty who is on the teaching staff of one of the parties signing this MOU.
- 4. Home Institution- the institution of legal education in which a respective Exchange Student of Faculty Member is respectively originally enrolled or affiliated.
- Host Institution- the institution of legal education to which a respective Exchange Student or Faculty Member is attached fior the duration of Exchange Period.

Article 2- Scope: Exchange of Students

- Qualifying students are those from the undergraduate, postgraduate programmes and doctoral programme of GRKCL and MLC.
- 2. A MAXIMUM OF FOUR Exchange Students at the undergraduate level, post graduate level and doctoral level each, can be sent to the partner institution each academic year. This number may vary in any given year, provided a balance of exchange is obtained over the term of this MOU. The numbers may be amended by mutual consent.

Article 3- Application

An Exchange Student is enrolled at his/her Home Institution and will not, by virtue of this MOU, be regarded as a candidate for a degree of the Host Institution. The award of the degree will continue to be governed by his/her home institution.

Article 4- Accomodation

- 1. The Host Instituion will attempt to assist Exchange Students to obtain, at the students' own expense, on-campus accommodation or, if not available, off-campus accommodation with reasonable access to the campus, e.g., by public transport.
- 2. The Host Institution, within its discretion and its capabilities, will provide further reasonable assistance to Exchange Students with respect to housing.

Article 5- Enrolment, Attendance and Assessment

- An Exchange Student is permitted to enrol at the Host Institution in any course, but enrolment is subject to admission requirements, course schedule and capacity constraints. The enrolment shall be subject to written acknowledgements from Principals of both the institutions.
- The Exchange Student must attend all courses for which he/she is enrolled, provided that "attendance" shall mean "attendance" as defined by the Host Institution.
- 3. An Exchange Student who has successfully completed courses at the Host Institution will obtain credits at the Home Institution in accordance to the regulations of the Home Institution.

Article 6- Students' Obligations

- 1. An Exchange Student shall pay tuition and other fees at his/her Home Institution during the Exchange Period. No tuition fees and other fees shall be payable to the Host Institution.
- 2. An Exchange Student is also liable for all personal expenses incurred at the Host Institution, including but not limited to expenses for travel, obtaining a visa, housing, meals, medical care, books and stationery.
- 3. An Exchange Student is required to cover, at his/her own expense, adequate travel and medical insurance for the entire period when he/she is away from his/her home country for purposes of study abroad, including the Exchange Period.
- 4. The home institution or the host institution is at liberty to provide stipend or any other such concessions to any exchange student.
- 5. An Exchange Student shall have no claim of any nature against the Home Institution and/or against the Host Institution in respect of any act, deed or thing done in pursuance of this MOU. The Exchange Student shall before opting for the programme sign the necessary declaration in this respect.

Article 7- Regulations of Host Institution

For the duration and purposes of the echange, all Exchange Students are subject to the academic rules and discipline of the Host Institution.

Article 8- Faculty Member Mobility

Whenever either of the parties hereto have a specific interest in involving members of the faculty of the other institution in their special lecture series, seminars and any other programmes or initiatives, all efforts will be made to make it possible, for which the expenses (accommodation and travel only) shall be borne by the concerned inviting party. The respective institution shall make efforts to obtain scholarships or other such benefits for such concerned faculty members, wherever applicable.

Article 9- Promotion of Academic Programmes, Resource sharing and Joint Initiatives

- Both Parties agree to the promotion of the academic programmes and initiatives for knowledge exchange, exchange of e-resources and other library resources, including on-line seminars, presentations by way of video conferencing and other means.
- Both parties shall explore organsing joint seminars, workshops, conferences and other events, either in Margao-Goa, Pune-Maharashtra or any other mutually agrees venue, (with prior discussions and agreement by Principals of both the institutuions) for which expenses will be shared equally, unless there is a proposal to the contarary.

Article 10- Duration & Termination

- 1. The present MOU shall be effective for a tenure of five years from the date of signing the MOU by both the parties.
- 2. Either party may, in its absolute discretion, terminate the MOU by giving written notice of an intention to terminate at least six months prior to the effective date of termination.
- 3. Termination will not affect exchanges in effect prior to the effective date of termination.

Article 12-Amendments

Any alteration or amendment to this MOU must be made in writing and agreed and accepted by both parties.

Artice 13- Applicable Law

Disputes arising out of or related to this MOU shall be resolved amicably, Disputes with respect to a particular Exchange Student shall be viewed and resolved in accordance with mutual agreement of Principals of both the institutions.

Wegrow, D-13, KIIMS, Bhubaneswar, Odisha THE SECOND PARTY (hereinafter called the Second Party), represented by Dr Ramesh Panda company which expression, unless excluded by or repugnant to the subject of context shall include its successors – in – office, administrators or assigns First and Second Party are hereinafter jointly referred to as PARTIES and individually as PARTY.

WHEREAS:

- A) First party is a higher education institution named: P.E.S.'s Modern Law College, Pune
- B) Second Party is a company named **Wegrow**,
- C) First Party and Second Party believe that collaboration and cooperation between themselves will promote effective use of each of their resources and provide each one of them enhanced opportunity.
- D) Both parties are legal entities in themselves desire to sign an MoU for advancing their mutual interest.

Now therefore, in consideration of the mutual promises set forth in this MoU, the parties hereto agree as follows

CLAUSE 1 COOPERATION

- 1.1 Both parties are united by common interest and objectives, and they shall establish channels of communication and cooperation that will promote and advance their respective operations within the institution and the related wings. The parties shall keep each other informed of potential opportunities and shall share information that may be relevant to secure additional opportunities.
- 1.2 First Party and Second Party cooperation will facilitate effective utilization of the intellectual capabilities of the faculty of the First Party providing significant inputs to them keeping in mind the needs of the industry.
- 1.3 The general terms of cooperation shall be governed by this MoU. The parties shall cooperate with each other, as promptly as is reasonably practical, enter into all relevant agreements, deeds and documents as may be required to give to the actions contemplated in terms of this MoU.

CLAUSE 2 SCOPE OF MoU

- 2.1 The budding graduates from this institution could play a key role in technological upgradation, innovation and competitiveness of an industry. Both parties believe that close cooperation between the two would be of major benefit to the students to enhance their skill and knowledge.
- 2.2 The Parties intent to cooperate and focus their efforts on cooperation in industry-based projects. The Second Party shall offer industry-based projects to the students and the faculty members of the First Party.
- 2.3 The Parties intent to cooperate and focus their efforts on cooperation within area of Skill Based Training, Education, internship, Placement, Industrial Visit, Expert Lecture.

2.4 Both the parties can agree to jointly work on research and development, designing new products and services.

2.5 There is no financial commitment on the part of both the parties for the work that is jointly executed. If there is any financial consideration, it will be dealt separately.

CLAUSE 3 INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY

3.1 Nothing contained in this MoU shall, by express grant, implication, estoppels or otherwise, create in either party any right, title, interest, or license in or to the intellectual property (including but not limited to know-how, inventions, patents copyrights and designs) of the other party.

CLAUSE 4 VALIDITY

- 4.1 This agreement is valid for a period of two years and thereafter can be renewed by mutual understanding of both the Parties.
- 4.2 In case any Party intends to terminate the agreement, a notice of thirty calendar days can be served to the other party. In the event of termination, both the Parties have to discharge their obligations.

CLAUSE RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN PARTIES

5.1 It is expressly agreed that the First Party and the Second Party are acting under this MoU as independent contractors, and the relationship established under this MoU shall not be construed as a partnership. Neither Party is authorized to use the other Party's name in any way, to make any presentations or create any obligation or liability, expressed or implied, on behalf of the other Party. Neither party shall have, or represent itself as having, any authority under the terms of this MoU, to make agreements of any kind in the name of or binding upon other Party, to pledge the other Party's credit, or to extend credit on behalf of the other Party.

Any divergence or differences derived from the interpretation or application of the MoU shall be resolved by arbitration between the Parties

The college is permanently affiliated to the Savitribai Phule Pune University, approved by the Bar Council of India and accredited by NAAC Bengaluru with A Grade. Modern Law College is a recognized Institution under the 2(f) and 12B of the UGC Act. The College currently conducts the BALLB, BBA LLB and LLB courses at the UG level, four diploma courses in Cyber Law, Intellectual Property Law, Labor Laws and Taxation Law, and LL.M course at the PG level. In this regard, Vilasrao Deshmukh Law College, Pune as the first party, is committed to achieving academic collaboration with institutions of excellence in the field of Law and social sciences

PURPOSE:

The MoU has been signed to offer additional options to law students to broaden their horizon in Law and to exchange legal awareness of legal aid and legal literacy. The MoU focuses on the following areas:

- Encouraging Joint events of legal literacy programmes between both institutes.
- Conducting Legal Aid Camps and Legal Training Programs involving law students, advocates, Judicial Officers, social workers and faculty members
- Hosting of Joint events and training programs for spreading awareness about legal literacy and Legal Aid.
- Collaborating on joint clinical programs for law students and members of society.
- Sharing of resources between the institutes and conducting mentorship programs for the students

SCOPE OF AGREEMENT

This memorandum of understanding has been signed between Mahatma Phure Vidya Pratisthan's Vilasrao Deshmukh Law College, Pune as the First Party and Progressive Education Society's Modern Law College, Pune as the Second Party for the purpose of academic/institutional collaboration that will encompass the exchange of students and members of faculty between the

two parties as well as other scholarly activities, research, and publication. In addition to this, active efforts will be made to develop joint training and research programs that will be pursued in a collaborative spirit. The collaboration between the first party and the second party shall be subject to the following: -

I. TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF COOPERATION:

- a. Vilasrao Deshmukh Law College, Pune and Modern Law College, Pune shall collaborate in mutually agreeable events, teaching, training, and research, wherever feasible. Such collaboration will be based on mutually agreeable terms, and conditions expressly agreed for each of the collaborative efforts;
- b. Vilasrao Deshmukh Law College, Pune and Modern Law College, Pune shall collaborate in conducting Faculty Development Programmes and other Academic Enrichment Programmes as well as National and International Seminars, Conferences, Workshops, etc.
- c. Faculty members of both parties shall be invited for seminars, conferences, and teaching at the doctoral level. The financial implications shall be worked out on a case-to-case basis.
- d. Vilasrao Deshmukh Law College, Pune and Modern Law College, Pune shall collaborate in conducting state-level moot court competitions and clinical legal education.
- e. Vilasrao Deshmukh Law College, Pune and Modern Law College, Pune shall collaborate in conducting outreach programs. A village shall be adopted for the Clinical Legal Education. Such Legal Aid Camps should be undertaken in the region of Maharashtra.
- f. The modalities for a similar exchange of researchers and faculty members will be laid down through mutual discussion that should be made operational for five years.
- g. Certificate courses conducted in collaboration, for which there will be faculty members and students from both the institutions will be able to participate in the course for which Modern Law College, Pune and Vilasrao Deshmukh Law College, Pune will give certificate.
- h. The Ph. D scholars of both parties shall be allowed to make use of the library resources of each other and to have academic interaction with the faculty.
- i. Research Scholars and the teaching faculty of both parties will explore the possibility of taking up collaborative research work and also apply for funding from national and international agencies, governments, and other funding agencies.
- Any financial implications emerging out of such collaborations (other than the fees of the students) shall be worked out and the decision will be taken with mutual agreement.



k. In case of any dispute that may crop up during the execution of the MoU, the matter shall be settled through arbitration, to the Arbitration Committee of a member nominated each by both the parties and one member jointly nominated by both the parties.

II. AREAS OF COOPERATION:

This Memorandum expresses a mutual desire by Vilasrao Deshmukh Law College, Pune and Modern Law College, Pune to cooperate in building intellectual and research capacity and scholarship. Additional areas of co-operation may be added by the written consent of both the parties. Both the parties will act in good faith to ensure that the objectives in this memorandum are realized.

III. TERMS OF AGREEMENT:

Progress in realizing the terms and conditions referred to herein will be reviewed periodically as mutually agreed and the memorandum may be amended at any time by mutual consent in writing.

IV. INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY AND CONFIDENTIALITY:

a. In respect of each project and programs of co-operation, the parties shall negotiate and mutually agree in writing on their respective rights to intellectual property and commercial exploitation of the same (including without limitation, trademarks and service marks, copyright, patents, designs, and confidential information pertaining thereto)

Neither party shall, at any time disclose to any third party any confidential information of the other party which is acquired within the course of activities under this Memorandum, a collaborative project or a programme, without the prior consent of the other party.

The Confidentiality obligations herein will not apply to information in the public domain, information in the possession of the receiving party prior to the disclosure of the information; information which is independently developed by the receiving party; information required to be released by law; and information which is rightfully received by the receiving party from third parties without any breach of confidentiality obligations.

V. NON-BINDING NATURE OF MEMORANDUM:
